

Electoral Literacy Club

Yes, an Electoral Literacy Club has been set up in the college since the 22th of November, 2021.

The students' co-ordinator and co-ordinating faculty members, who are Assistant Professors from the Political Science Department, are appointed by the college. The ELC has been functional since its registration in 2021. The ELC of Shree Shree Gourgobind college is representative in nature as the Convenor and members of the Executive Council are elected in a democratic manner from the student population of the college.

The ELC of the college has extensively participated in SVEEP activities organized by the District Election Office and its students have participated in various voter awareness programmes both within and outside the college campus. The ELC of the college regularly conducts and maintains activities such as the Wall of Democracy and Ballot Bistro to actively engage the students in discussions of current and contemporary issues in the political sphere. The college maintains a board in front of the Political Science Department with the purpose of displaying various contents related to electoral literacy. This board is referred to as the Wall of Democracy and the purpose of the board is to create and share electoral literacy in a creative and engaging manner to encourage student participation. The board is managed by the Executive Committee and the theme of the board is changed every month. Once the theme for a month is decided, the managing committee invites contribution from students of all semesters. The board also display important announcements regarding major ELC activities. The ELC also regularly organises in house discussions and brainstorming sessions in the college canteen and girls' common room in the form of ballot bistros. The discussion sessions are open to both non-members and members of the ELC. The ELC organises these ballot bistros with the aim of involving maximum numbers of participants through its informal nature which is a reminiscent of retro culture of coffee house discussions.

The college has also taken up various initiatives in electoral related issues to highlight the importance of participation in electoral process and its role in advancement of democratic values, especially in light of the Manipur Legislative Assembly Elections of 2022. The ELC of Shree Shree Gourgobind College spearheaded Electoral Awareness drives geared towards housewives and senior citizens of the locality. The students of the college put forward a short play to engage the local community into discussions of the importance of community participation in the electoral process.
